The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT the McLeod-Scanlon Amusements, Ltd., owners of the Patricia Theatre, Powell River, B. C. overpaid in error the amusement tax to the extent of \$922.47 between February 1st, 1922 and January 31st, 1924. During this period and on examination of their books it was found that the gross receipts from admissions, exclusive of the amusement tax, amounted to \$24,873.66. The amusement tax thereon at 10% amounts to \$2487.36 which less the 5% commission allowed by regulations, makes a correct tax payable of \$2363.00. The tax paid amounted to a sum of \$3285.47, making an overpayment of \$922.47. The overpayment was made through the fact that amusement tax tickets of the denominations of 2¢ and 4¢ were used in respect to admission fees of 15¢ and 35¢ instead of 1½¢ and 3½¢.

AND TO RECOMMEND under the provisions of Section 2 of the Revenue Act Amendment Act, 1920 that the McLeod-Scanlon Amusements Ltd. be refunded the sum of \$922.47 thus overpaid.
