The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:-

THAT the following lands were resumed by the Crown consequent upon the failure of the purchasers to complete payment of the purchase thereof:- Lot J, Block 18; Lots 6, 8 and 9, Block 133, District Lot 343, Cariboo District, City of Prince George.

THAT in furtherance of an auction the lands have since been resold.

THAT while held under agreement to purchase the said lands were subject to taxes imposed thereon by the City of Prince George up to the 31st March, 1921, the date they again became the property of the Crown.

THAT a claim in the sum of one thousand seven hundred and eighty two dollars and eleven cents (\$1,782.11) to cover said taxes has been filed by the City of Prince George verified by the certificate of the assessor and collector.


THAT of the sum so far collected from the resale of these lots \$1,609.76 is available towards the payment of the said claim.

AND TO RECOMMEND in accordance with the provisions of Section 9 of Chapter 69 of the Statutes of 1918, that payment be made to the City of Prince George from the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the sum of one thousand six hundred and nine dollars and seventy six cents (\$1,609.76).
