



The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:


The undersigned has the honour to recommend:-

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 45 and Section 46 (1) of the Taxation Act, being Chapter 75 of the Statutes of British Columbia, 1922, the rate to be fixed by regulations, is hereby fixed at two per centum of the gross income of non-resident traders doing business in the Province through resident traders, and of nonresident persons doing business temporarily in the Province. And that same do take effect forthwith.
