

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:-


THAT an Order-in-Council approved on the 13th January, 1923, authorized the issuance of a lease to Wm. D. Scott, A.J. Freeman, Leo C. Johnson and R.H. Greene covering lands embraced in Coal and Petroleum Licence No. 2162, for a period of five years from the 17th October, 1922, provided that a satisfactory survey was furnished within six months of the approval of the Minute.

THAT a further extension of one year was granted by Order-in-Council No. 1015 approved on the 21st August, 1923, said extension expiring on the 13th July, 1924.


THAT application for a further extension of three months has been received.

AND TO RECOMMEND that under authority contained in Section 21, Chapter 159, Revised Statutes 1911, being the "Coal and Petroleum Act" a further extension of three months from the 13th July, 1924, be granted in which to complete the survey of the lands embraced in Coal and Petroleum Licence No. 2162 and renewals thereof.
