

WHAT under the provisions of the Government Liquor Act, the Liquor Control Board, by Resolution No.907 dated the 21st day of July, 1924, appointed James Francis Feeney Vendor at a salary of One Hundred and Sixty (\$160.00) dollars per month, such salary to be paid for such time and periods only during which the aforesaid employee of the Liquor Control Board shall be in charge of the Government Liquor Stores in the absence of the duly appointed Vendors of such stores.
