To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT by Section 11 of the "Department of Industries Act" being Chapter 34 of the Statutes of British Columbia for the year 1919 as amended by "Department of Industries Act Amendment Act 1920" the "Department of Industries Act Amendment Act 1921" and the "British Columbia Loan Acts Amendment Act 1921" power is given to the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council to renew and re-issue Treasury Bills issued under the said Act:

THAT in pursuance of Orders-in-Council approved on the 19th day of June, 1924, and 5th day of June, 1924, numbered 697 and 641, the following Treasury Bills as dated and numbered bearing interest at the rate of five per cent per annum and amounting in the aggregate to One hundred and Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.) were issued to The Canadian Bank of Commerce.

THAT the Minister of Finance has arranged with The Canadian Bank of Commerce to issue to The Canadian Bank of Commerce in renewal of both of the said Treasury Bills dated and numbered as above recited a Treasury Bill in the form following:-

This Treasury Bill entitles The Canadian Bank of Commerce or order to payment of One hundred and twenty-five Thousand Dollars with interest at five per cent per annum at the Banking House of The Canadian Bank of Commerce, Victoria, B.C., out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Province of British Columbia on the 2nd day of October, 1924."

AND THAT The Canadian Bank of Commerce has agreed to accept the said Treasury Bill in renewal of both of the said Treasury Bills dated and numbered as above recited:

AND TO RECOMMEND

THAT the renewal of both of the said Treasury Bills dated and numbered as above recited, in the manner and on the terms set out in the recitals hereto be approved:

AND THAT a certified copy of this Minute, if approved by the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council, be transmitted to The Canadian Bank of Commerce.
