To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:-

THAT it has been found that the time allowed for the returning of the writ issued under the provisions of section 4. of the "Liquor Control Plebiscites Act" on the tenth day of May, 1924, to W. Douglas Balfour, of Vancouver, Returning Officer for the Vancouver City Electoral District, is insufficient, and that it is necessary an extension of such time and an alteration of the date consequent thereon should be made;

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT in pursuance of the provisions of section 187 of the "Provincial Elections Act", and in pursuance of all other powers thereunto enabling, the time allowed in and by the said writ for the returning thereof be extended, and that the day on or before which the said writ shall be returnable be altered from the first day of August, 1924, being the day mentioned in the said writ, to the second day of September, 1924;

AND THAT the same be declared by notification in the Gazette.
