The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:-

THAT application has been made on behalf of the Granby Consolidated Mining, Smelting and Power Company Limited, for a Crown Grant of certain lots in the subdivision of Lot 494, Similkameen Division of Yale District, also a small piece of the undivided part of said Lot, which, according to evidence furnished, stands registered in the name of the Yale Hotel Company Limited, dissolved under Section 268 of the Companies' Act 1910, on the 22nd day of February 1914.

THAT it is represented that either a conveyance from the Yale Hotel Company Limited to the Granby Consolidated Mining, Smelting and Power Company Limited, has been lost, or that the Granby Consolidated Mining, Smelting and Power Company Limited treated the property in question as belonging to it in virtue of its ownership of the remainder of the subdivision and lands adjacent, and have been assessed and paid taxes thereon since 1906.

THAT the application is made in the belief that on the dissolution of the Yale Hotel Company Limited, its lands reverted to the Crown.

AND TO RECOMMEND

THAT under the circumstances, any right, title and interest of the Crown, by virtue of the alleged reversion in the property referred to, described as follows, be granted and Quit-Claimed to the Granby Consolidated Mining, Smelting and Power Company Limited, without charge.

"An equal undivided one-half interest in all that portion of Lot 494, in Group 1, in the Similkameen (formerly Osoyoos) Division of Yale District, in the Province of British Columbia, lying to the north of the southern boundary of the said Lot 494 and to the west of the line described as commencing from a point on the south boundary of the said Lot 494, situated North 88 40', West a distance of 3911.5 feet measured along the said south boundary from the south-east corner of the said Lot 494; thence running north 7 08', West a distance of 587.1 feet, to the intersection of the left bank of the North Fork of the Kettle River with the said line, except that portion thereof comprised under the map numbered 89 and deposited in the Land Registry Office at the City of Kamloops."

AND All the lots and parts of lots shown on the map numbered 89, deposited in the Land Registry Office at the City of Kamloops, lying north of the southern boundary of Lot 494, in Group 1, in the Similkameen (formerly Osoyoos) Division of Yale District in the Province of British Columbia, and west of the line described as commencing from a point on the south boundary of the said Lot 494, situated north 88 40', West a distance of 3911.5 feet measured along the said south boundary from the south-east corner of the said Lot 494; thence running north 7 08', West a distance of 587.1 feet to the intersection of the left bank of the North Fork of the Kettle River with the said line.

AND FURTHER TO RECOMMEND

THAT a certified copy of this Minute, if approved, be transmitted to the Registrar, Land Registry Office, Kamloops, B.C., to the intent that such certified copy be accepted by him as a Conveyance and Quit-Claim of any right, title and interest of the Crown by virtue of the dissolution of the Yale Hotel Company Limited, in the above described land, without further formal instrument of transfer.
