To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report for the consideration of the Council the following:

That the "Twin Lakes Timber Company" was incorporated in the State of Delaware, U.S.A. on the 27th August 1923, and registered as an extra-provincial company under the "Companies Act, 1921" on the 30th January 1924:

That its authorized capital stock consists of One thousand shares without nominal or par value and for the purposes of registration, and subject to adjustment, Seventy-seven dollars and fifty cents were paid as fees in respect thereof under item 6 of the Third Schedule of the said Act:

That a sworn statement of the president of the Company has been lodged with the Registrar of Joint Stock Companies that the gross assets of the company consist of One thousand dollars, on which the fees would amount only to Twenty-five dollars:

That subsection (2) of Section 30 of the "Revenue Act" being Chapter 202 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1911" as enacted by Chapter 79 of the Statutes of 1920, empowers the Lieutenant-Governor -in-Council to refund by payment from the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the person entitled thereto any moneys erroneously paid or collected and received into revenue:

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT in exercise of the power conferred by the "Revenue Act" as recited, the Minister of Finance be authorized to refund by payment from the Consolidated Revenue Fund to Messrs E. P. Davis and Com. of Vancouver, Solicitors for the company, the sum of Fifty-two dollars and fifty cents, being the amount overpaid as above set forth
