The undersigned has the honour to

REPORT:

THAT one Thomas Robinson is imprisoned for safe custody in the local Police prison at Burnaby charged with an offence for that he did at Burnaby aforesaid on or about the 19th day of June, 1924, unlawfully have carnal knowledge of Frances Polinsky, a girl under the age of 14 years, not being his wife.

THAT Dr. H.C. Steeves, Medical Superintendent of the Public Hospital for the Insane, and Dr. J.G. McKay of Vancouver, and Dr. G.H. Manchester of Vancouver, have examined the said accused as to his mental condition and each has reported that in his opinion the said Thomas Robinson is insane.

THAT the aforesaid evidence as to the insanity of the said Thomas Robinson is considered sufficient:

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT the said Thomas Robinson be removed from the said Police prison at Burnaby to the Public Hospital for the Insane at Essondale, there to remain until his complete or partial recovery is certified to the satisfaction of the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council:

AND THAT certified copies of this minute, if approved, be forwarded to W.J. Devitt, Chief Constable for the Municipality of Burnaby at Edmonds, and to Dr. H.C. Steeves, Medical Superintendent as aforesaid.
