REPORT:

THAT Section 29 of the Dewdney Dyking District Act, being Chapter 8 of the Statutes of British Columbia 1923, provides that upon the execution of an agreement between the Commissioners as in the said Act defined and the Trustee as in the said Act defined, and assented to by the majority in value of the owners as defined in Section 5 thereof, the said Act shall come into force by proclamation of the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council.

THAT on the 3rd day of May 1924 the above-mentioned agreement was duly executed by the said parties and assented to by the said owners as aforesaid, pursuant to the provisions of said Section 29

AND TO RECOMMEND that a proclamation bringing into operation the said Act as and from the date of this Order be issued pursuant to Section 29 thereof.
