The undersigned has the honour to recommend:-

THAT Order-in-Council Number 863, approved the first day of August, 1924, appointing JOHN LEE of Revelstoke, B. C., to the several offices in the said Order-in-Council set out, be rescinded; and

THAT in pursuance of Section 3 of the "Magistrates Act" the said John Lee be appointed to be Stipendiary Magistrate for the County of Kootenay and the County of Yale, and that a Commission under the Great Seal do issue accordingly; and

THAT in pursuance of Section 3 of the "Small Debts Court Act," the said John Lee, as such Stipendiary Magistrate, be appointed to exercise within the Revelstoke Electoral District the jurisdiction conferred by the "Small Debts Court Act;" and

THAT in pursuance of Section 19 of the "Supreme Court Act," the said John Lee be appointed District Registrar of the Supreme Court for the Revelstoke Registry; and

THAT in pursuance of Section 13 of the "County Courts Act," the said John Lee be appointed Registrar of the County Court of West Kootenay, at Revelstoke; and

THAT in pursuance of Section 183 of the "County Courts Act," the said John Lee be appointed to be Clerk of the Peace in the County of Kootenay.
