The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT in the Estimates for the present fiscal year (1924-1925) the sum of Sixteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$16,500.00) was provided under Vote 10 for "Control of Fruit Pests, Diseases, etc."

THAT of this amount, the sum of Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000.00) was set aside for the purpose of paying wages, expenses, etc., in connection with the Control of Codling Moth and the balance (\$2,500.00) reserved to pay similar expenses incurred in connection with other pest control work.

THAT the said sum of Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000.00) reserved for Codling Moth Control has now been expended, and it has therefore become necessary to

RECOMMEND

THAT pursuant to Section 3 of the "Codling-moth Control Act, 1922" the additional sums necessary for the continuation of this work be advanced from the Consolidated Revenue Fund, to an amount not exceeding Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) for the fiscal year ending 31st March, 1925.
