


The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:-

THAT it has been found that the extension of time allowed by Order-in-Council No. 843, approved on the 30th day of July, 1924, for the returning of the Writ of Election issued on the tenth day of May, 1924, to W. Douglas Balfour, of Vancouver, Returning Officer for the Vancouver City Electoral District, is insufficient, and that it is necessary a further extension of such time and an alteration of the date consequent thereon should be made;

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT in pursuance of the provisions of section 187 of the "Provincial Elections Act", and in pursuance of all other powers thereunto enabling, the time allowed in and by the said Writ of Election for the returning thereof be further extended, and that the day on or before which the said Writ of Election shall be returnable be altered from the second day of September, 1924, being the day mentioned in the said Order-in-Council No. 843, to the fifteenth day of September, 1924;

AND THAT the same be declared by notification in the Gazette.
