The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to **report:**

THAT the attention of the Department of Lands has been drawn to the fact that a number of squatters are located upon the Kitsilano Indian Reserve and on the foreshore abutting the same:

THAT complaints have also been made to the effect that the condition of the shacks and buildings erected by these squatters are at variance with the building and health regulations, and that such occupation is undesirable not only for the reasons stated, but from the standpoint of law and order:

THAT an official of the Department of Lands has made an examination and report upon the situation which confirms the complaints referred to:

AND TO RECOMMEND:

THAT notice be posted on the ground in question to the effect that on and after the first day of January 1925, no squatters will be allowed thereon and that any buildings, tents, or other structures used for habitation not removed before the first day of February 1925, will be forcibly taken off and destroyed.
