The undersigned has the honour to report

THAT by Order-in-Council No.560 approved the 14th day of May, 1924, a Special Warrant (No.3) did issue in the sum of Twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) to meet additional expenses of the Commission appointed to inquire into matters relating to the Pacific Great Eastern Railway Company.

THAT the said sum of Twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) has been found to be insufficient to meet said additional expenses of the said Commission.

THAT the sum of Eight hundred and ninety-seven dollars and ninety-nine cents (\$897.99) over and above the said amount provided by Special Warrant No.3 is required to complete the payment of the aforesaid expenses.

THE UNDERSIGNED HAS THEREFORE THE HONOUR TO RECOMMEND, under authority of Clause (b) of Section 24 of the "Audit Act," being Chapter 7 of the Statutes of British Columbia, 1917, that a Special Warrant do issue in the said sum of Eight hundred and ninety-seven dollars and ninety-nine cents (\$897.99) for the purposes above set out, such sum being urgently and immediately required for the public good.
