To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:-

THAT under the "Dewdney Municipality Relief Act" being Chapter 15 of the 1906 Statutes of British Columbia and the "Dewdney Municipality Relief Tax Remissions Act", being Chapter 6 of the 1912 Statutes of British Columbia, taxes amounting to \$107.10 were levied against the E. 1/4 of Section 13 of Township 18 owned by Regis Hudon and that the said Regis Hudon has declared under affidavit dated 8th August 1924 as follows:-

"That I did execute Road work for the Corporation of the District of Dewdney prior to the cancellation of the said Corporation to the value of One Hundred and Twenty (\$120) Dollars and that I did not receive payment from the said Corporation or from the Government of the Province of British Columbia, which assumed certain liabilities at the date of said cancellation, viz: Mar. 18th, 1906."

And to report:-


THAT the said Regis Hudon has paid \$5.10 on account of said taxes.

And to report:-

THAT though there is no record of the Government having taken over any liability in this matter, that it would be a hardship to enforce the collection of the said tax against the said Regis Hudon.


