The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT application has been made by W.G. Hadikin of Nelson, British Columbia, to purchase the East half of District Lot 5180, Kootenay District situate to the West of the city of Nelson, and consisting of 60 acres.

THAT the applicant and his family have been in occupation of this land, claiming to have been under the impression of having paid rent in respect thereof to a person now deceased, and is desirous of validating this occupancy thereof, and protecting the improvements made and has agreed to pay the appraised value of Five Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$ 5.50 ) per acre, therefor,
