The undersigned has the honour to report for the consideration of the Council the following:

THAT in the matter of the Estate of the late EDMUND LEROY THOMPSON, deceased, Succession Duty in the sum of \$499.46 was paid to the Registrar of the Supreme Court at Prince George, on a net sworn valuation of \$10,009.32:

AND WHEREAS further debts amounting to \$1746.45 have been proved against the Estate, reducing the assessable value from \$10,009.32 to \$8,262.87:

AND WHEREAS the Succession Duty payable has in consequence been reduced from \$499.46 to \$412.13:

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under Section 2, Chapter 79 of the "Revenue Act of 1920" the amount of \$87.33 overpaid be refunded to the Executor of the Estate.
