

To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

WHEREAS the Consolidated Distilleries, Limited, has a Distillers' License from the Government of the Dominion of Canada to carry on its business in the Province of British Columbia;

AND WHEREAS the Head Office of the said Company is in the Province of Ontario;

AND WHEREAS the said Company in May last shipped in bond certain liquor manufactured by the said Company in Ontario, to the City of Vancouver;

AND WHEREAS the duty was paid on the said liquor in Vancouver and said liquor was moved by the said Company to its plant at Granville Island, for the purpose, as the Company alleges, of exportation;


AND WHEREAS the said liquor was seized by the Government on the ground that said liquor was not held in an Export Warehouse as provided by Section 54 of the Government Liquor Act;

AND WHEREAS the Company, through its Solicitors, has represented to the Government that it believes that the provision of said Section 54 of the Government Liquor Act does not constitutionally apply to the liquor in question, but has further represented to the Government that it does not wish to run counter to the wishes of the Government or its policy, and is prepared to discontinue the practice of removing liquor from bond unless it takes out an Export License;


AND WHEREAS under the circumstances it is not deemed advisable to enter a prosecution against the said Company for its alleged violation of said Section 54 of the Government Liquor Act, nor that any technical forfeiture be imposed without a prosecution;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed right and conducive to the public good to remit the forfeiture of the said liquor;

THEREFORE THE UNDERSIGNED HAS THE HONOUR TO RECOMMEND that under the provisions of the Revenue Act the forfeiture of the said liquor be remitted and that the said liquor be returned forthwith to the said Company.
