The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT bearing upon Section 58, Sub-section 1 of the Dyking Assessments Adjustment Act 1905, Amendment Act 1920, a petition from the majority in value of the owners of lands lying in the Maple Ridge Dyking District was received, praying that a comprehensive scheme of drainage be provided for those lands under that enactment.

THAT the necessary survey work has been done, the necessary plans, memoranda and estimates prepared by the Inspector of Dykes as provided for in that enactment.

THAT a duplicate plan and assessment roll have been duly signed and deposited in the Land Registry Office.

AND THAT the Corporation of the Municipality of Pitt Meadows desire to contribute \$16,500 towards the cost of this work in equal annual payments along with the land owners concerned.

AND TO RECOMMEND that under the authority contained in Section 58, Sub-Section 4, Dyking Assessments Adjustment Act 1905, Amendment Act 1920, the repayment of any monies advanced by the Minister of Finance for the construction of Drainage works in the Maple Ridge Dyking District, which Drainage works are known as "Maple Ridge Drainage No. 2," be extended over a period of fifteen years, from the date of completion of the works.

THAT the monies so advanced shall bear interest at the rate of six per centum per annum.
