To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT the West Kootenay Power and Light Co., Ltd. and the South Kootenay Water, Power and Light Co., Ltd., both of Rossland, B. C., in the month of June, 1924 remitted a sum of money to the Collector at Penticton with instructions to apply it to the taxes due on certain specifically described properties. In error the Collector applied the sum of \$19.50 of the former Company's remittance and the sum of \$10.00 of the latter's remittance to the wrong properties.

AND TO RECOMMEND under the provisions of Section 2 of the Revenue Act, Amendment Act 1920

THAT a rebate be made of the sums thus erroneously brought to revenue of \$19.50 and \$10.00 be respectively refunded to the West Kootenay Power and Light Co. Ltd. and the South Kootenay Water, Power and Light Co. Ltd., the said refunds to be made payable to the Collector for the purpose of properly bringing to account.
