

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report

WHEREAS the Honourable the Minister of Public Works has by notice published in the British Columbia Gazette discontinued and closed a portion of Granville Street (Port Hardy) through part of N.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 36, Tp. 9, Rupert District, and more particularly described as follows:-

That portion of Granville Street lying east of the easterly boundary line of the newly gazetted road to the wharf, to high water mark at Hardy Bay. The said easterly boundary of the newly gazetted road commencing at a point on the north boundary of Granville Street two hundred and eighteen (218) feet, more or less, east from the South-west corner of Lot "E" Registered Plan 2178; thence South 61 Degrees 28 Minutes West One hundred and thirty-eight and two-tenths (138.2) feet more or less, to the south boundary of said Granville Street.

AND WHEREAS by virtue of Section 10.A. of the "Highway Act" as amended by Section 3 of the "Highway Act Amendment Act of 1917," the Honourable the Minister of Public Works is empowered under the authority of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to transfer the land comprised in such highway so discontinued and closed to the owner of the land of which it originally formed part.

AND WHEREAS the said Minister has agreed to transfer the said land to Ada Mildred Goodacre of Victoria, B. C., owner of the land of which the said above described lands originally formed part for the consideration of One (1) Dollar.
