The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT formal application has been made on behalf of the Pacific Great Eastern Railway Company for a free grant of lands for Townsite purposes, surveyed as Lot 2246, Group 1, New Westminster District, containing 565 acres, more or less.

THAT under the Provisions of Paragraph "D" of Section 13 of Schedule "A" to Chapter 34 of the Statutes of 1912, lands required by the Company for Townsites are to be administered under the terms of an agreement entered into between the Government and Company. An agreement in accordance with the Provisions of said Paragraph "D" has been completed and signed by the Company and the Honourable the Minister of Lands, as representing the Province.
