

ORDER OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL

Order in Council No. **1122**, Approved and Ordered AUG. 15, 1991

On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

WHEREAS Bruce Alfred BLACKMAN is a person who was found not guilty by reason of insanity on a charge of first degree murder (six counts), by The Honourable Mr. Justice McKenzie of Supreme Court of British Columbia at New Westminster on November 4, 1983, and was ordered to be kept in strict custody at the Forensic Psychiatric Institute, until the pleasure of the Lieutenant-Governor is known;

AND WHEREAS under Order-in-Council number 2184 approved December 20, 1984, was ordered to be detained in safe custody at the Forensic Psychiatric Institute until further order;

AND WHEREAS satisfactory evidence of his progress and recovery from mental illness has been submitted, and a conditional discharge has been recommended by the Order-in-Council Patients Review Board as being in his best interest and not contrary to the interest of the public, and that Bruce Alfred BLACKMAN be discharged conditionally subject to the following conditions;

That he be subject to the direction and supervision of the Director of the Forensic Psychiatric Services or his nominee;

That he reside in the Forensic Psychiatric Institute or at such place operated by the Forensic Psychiatric Service Commission as deemed appropriate by the Director or his nominee;

That he shall remain at the place of residence for purposes of his treatment or rehabilitation as directed by the Director or his nominee;

That he shall take such medication and treatment as may be prescribed by the Director or his nominee;

That he shall not acquire, possess or use any firearm or offensive weapon;

That he shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour and refrain from the use of alcohol or unprescribed drugs;

That he shall present himself before the Order-in-Council Patients Review Board when required by the chairman thereof;

Order-in-Council number 2184 approved December 20, 1984 be rescinded and Bruce Alfred BLACKMAN be discharged conditionally subject to the conditions referred to above, and subject to being further dealt with as provided in Section 617 of the Criminal Code if he violates any condition of his discharge.
