The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:-

THAT formal application has been made by Cedric Rupert Hay for a Quit Claim Grant of the reversionary interest of the Province in a portion of the Halalt Indian Reserve Number 2, containing 59/100 of an acre, which has been designated Lot 173-G, Chemainus District.

THAT Mr. Hay has submitted the Indian Land Sale Grant issued by the Dominion Government in his favour, covering their rights in said parcel of land.

AND TO RECOMMEND under authority of Section 127 of Chapter 129 of the Revised Statutes of 1911, that a Quit Claim Grant of the reversionary interest of the Province in Lot 173-G, Chemainus District, containing 59/100 of an acre, more or less, be issued in favour of Cedric Rupert Hay upon payment of the sum of \$15.00 and the usual Crown Grant fee of \$10.00.
