The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:-

THAT WHEREAS it appears necessary that the Sales Tax on manufactured fruit and vegetable products should be removed to permit of such products competing successfully with fresh fruits and vegetables imported into Canada which bear no such Sales Tax.

TO RECOMMEND that the sum of Five hundred dollars (\$500.00) be made available from Vote 38 - "Incidentals and Contingencies" by way of a grant to The British Columbia Fruit-Growers' Association to assist in defraying expenses of a delegation from British Columbia to co-operate with similar delegations from other Provinces in making representations to the Federal Government at Ottawa for removal of the Sales Tax on fruit and vegetable products manufactured in Canada.
