To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT Lot 1970, Kootenay District, being the "Sunset" Mineral Claim, has reverted to the Crown for non-payment of taxes.

THAT the said Lot lies within the Dominion Government Railway Belt and its boundaries are now practically obliterated on the ground. It is therefore inconvenient and inadvisable to deal with the said Lot under the "Taxation Act".

THAT the Gold Commissioner at Revelstoke reports that no lease has issued for the said Lot under the "Taxation Act".

AND TO RECOMMEND that under the authority of Section 181, Chapter 75, "Taxation Act, 1922" the Surveyor General be empowered to cancel the survey, field notes and official plan of survey of the said "Sunset" Mineral Claim, being Lot 1970, Kootenay District.
