Pursuant to the ~~Lieutenant-Governor~~ ^{Forest} Administrator Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the ~~Lieutenant-Governor~~, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that the following corporations be permitted to export wood chips during the period May 1, 1976 to April 30, 1977, up to the maximum quantities listed, upon payment of a timber tax of \$1.50 per bone dry unit or equivalent, or such other sum as is set by the Deputy Minister.

- Wood Chip Export Permit # 9 - Crown Zellerbach Canada Ltd - 150,000 G.P.U's
- Wood Chip Export Permit #12 - B.C. Forest Products Ltd. - 100,000 G.P.U's
- Wood Chip Export Permit #41 - MacMillan Bloedel Limited. - 100,000 G.P.U's
