**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia,  
enacts as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Coal and Petroleum Act Amend- Short title.  
ment Act, 1923."

2. Section 21 of the "Coal and Petroleum Act," being chapter 159 Amends s. 21.  
of the "Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1911," is amended  
by inserting after the word "lease," in the ninth line of subsection  
(2), the words "Upon good cause being shown to the satisfaction  
of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, and upon payment by the  
holder of the like sum as in case of the first renewal, the Lieutenant-  
Governor in Council may grant a second renewal of the lease for a  
further term of three years, subject to the like terms, conditions,  
and rentals and with the like effect as in the case of the first renewal."
