EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA APR. 29 1976

Pursuant to the Highway Act, Section 11 (2) (a) ~~Act~~, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Administrator ~~Lieutenant-Governor~~, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

WHEREAS by Notice dated June 7th., 1973 and published in The British Columbia Gazette of June 14th., 1973, notice of amendment dated September 26th., 1974, and published in The British Columbia Gazette of October 10th., 1974, and notice of amendment dated February 5th., 1976 and published in The British Columbia Gazette of February 12th., 1976, the Minister of Highways and Public Works discontinued and closed all that part of Palmer Road in District Lot 149, Nanoose District, dedicated by Plan 1917, as shown outlined in green on a plan recorded in the Provincial Department of Highways, Victoria, British Columbia, on File 2070-1.

AND WHEREAS the Minister of Highways and Public Works deems it desirable to transfer to ALICE MYRTLE WOOD, Homemaker, Box 109, Coombs, British Columbia, Executrix of the Will of Fredrick William Wood, deceased, DD C74719, the registered owner of that part of Lot 6 of District Lot 149, Nanoose District, Plan 1917, lying to the north of a boundary parallel to the northerly boundary of Parcel "A" (DD 5007-N) of Lots 6 and 7 of said Plan and extending from a point on the Westerly boundary of said Lot 6, distant 12.03 chains from the north-west corner of said Parcel "A", the owner of the adjacent land.

THE LAND COMPRISED in the portion of road allowance hereinbefore mentioned be transferred to ALICE MYRTLE WOOD, Executrix of the Will of Fredrick William Wood, deceased, without further of formal instrument of transfer, but upon compliance with the provisions of the "Land Registry Act" and the possible requirement that a subdivision plan be provided, subject to the conditions of the "Highway Act" and all other powers thereunto enabling, subject to the reservations, limitations, provisos, and conditions expressed in the original grant thereof from the Crown, and to the registered charges, if any, to which the said adjoining lands are subject, with the intent that the land hereby transferred be added to and form part of the said adjoining land, and that the Minister of Highways and Public Works be authorized to execute and deliver such further assurances of the above described lands as may in the premises be required.

AND FURTHER ORDERS THAT Order-in-Council No. 3814[✓], approved and ordered December 4th., 1974, be rescinded.
