To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

(1). THAT the Royal Trust Company on behalf of certain estates for whom they were acting, viz: the Buckley Marriage Settlement; Charles Gridland Estate; Miss Mary M.M. Grant Settlement Trust; Alexander Munro Estate; made returns of income for the year ended December 31st. 1921, and these returns were accepted as the basis of assessment and the taxes were levied and duly paid by the Company. In each case, however, the income accruing to the estate was less than the statutory rebate allowance, and should never have been assessed.

(2). THAT McIntyre's Cafe, Vancouver, paid income tax for 1920 amounting to \$247.32, based on income earned during the year ended December 31st. 1918. A Departmental audit reveals an over-payment of \$171.39, mainly accounted for by reason of the omission from the original return of an item paid in wages, which has materially altered the assessment.

(3) THAT according to the records of the Lands Department, Mr. W.V. Livingstone, Quesnel, B. C. abandoned Certificate of Purchase No. 4299 on June 2nd. 1921, but through an oversight the Assessor failed to delete the entry from his rolls with the result that Mr. Livingstone in error paid the 1922 and 1923 taxes.

AND to recommend under the provisions of Section 2 of the "Revenue Act Amendment Act, 1920" being Chapter 79.


(1). THAT the Royal Trust Company be refunded the respective sums of \$8.00; \$4.78; \$11.95; \$8.46, paid respectively on behalf of the estates

mentioned in the report


(2). THAT McIntyre's Cafe be refunded the sum of \$171.39, of which, however, \$19.20 is to be payable to the Provincial Collector, Vancouver, to be applied to the 1923 tax due by this tax-payer.

(3) THAT Mr. W.V. Livingstone be refunded the sum of \$8.00.
