

To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to Recommend:

THAT pursuant to the provisions of Section 59 of the Water Act 1914, as amended, the reservation of the unrecorded waters of all streams on the mainland of the Province of British Columbia lying within the area bounded by the arc of a circle described with a radius of 100 miles and with its centre at the City Hall, Vancouver, established by Order-in-Council numbered 1574 and approved the 15th day of November 1922, be cancelled.

THAT notice of such cancellation be published for three months in the British Columbia Gazette and for three months, in one issue each month, in some newspaper published in the Vancouver Water District.
