The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:-

THAT Lots 944, 945, 1074, 1075, 1434, 1592, 1900, 1901 and 1903, Similkameen, formerly Osoyoos, Division of Yale District, being the "Favourite", "Waneta", "Achme", "Micawber", "Gold Dust", "Little Gold Dust", "Head Light", "Peacock" and "Nickerson" mineral claims respectively, have reverted to the Crown for non-payment of taxes.

THAT the said lots are within the boundaries of the area known as the Southern Okanagan Project, and it is, therefore, inconvenient and inadvisable to deal with the said lots under the "Taxation Act".

THAT the Gold Commissioner at Penticton, B.C. reports that no leases have issued, nor are there any applications for lease pending under the "Taxation Act" covering these Claims.

AND TO RECOMMEND that under the authority of Section 181, Chapter 75, "Taxation Act, 1922" the Surveyor General be empowered to cancel the survey, field notes and official plans of survey of the said "Favourite", "Waneta", "Achme", "Micawber", "Gold Dust", "Little Gold Dust", "Head Light", "Peacock" and "Nickerson" mineral claims, being Lots 944, 945, 1074, 1075, 1434, 1592, 1900, 1901 and 1903, Similkameen, formerly Osoyoos, Division of Yale District.
