To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report

WHEREAS by Sections 37 and 38 of the "Highway Act Amendment Act, 1920," all highways within the limits of a Municipality, containing in the case of a city a population of not more than one thousand five hundred, shall be classified as primary, secondary and local, respectively, according to their importance in accordance with the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Public Works.

AND WHEREAS by Section 39 of the said Highway Act the said Minister has power to denote the highways which, in his opinion, should be classified primary and secondary highways respectively, by delineating upon a map the route of each such highway throughout each Municipal area through or in which it runs or is intended to run.

AND WHEREAS in accordance with said Section 39 of the said Act, the said Minister has entered into an agreement (ratified by Bylaw No. 225) and dated October 1st, 1923, with the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of West Vancouver, whereby the said Municipal Council has approved of the classification and route of secondary highways through the said Municipality and in pursuance of said Agreement and said Section 39, the said Minister has delineated in yellow the route of the following secondary highway throughout the said Municipality on a Map of the said Municipality.
