To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report

THAT on the 29th day of August last, at the City of Cranbrook, in the Province of British Columbia, before John Leask, Esquire, Police Magistrate in and for the said City, Donald Perry Percival was convicted for that he did unlawfully have in his possession a drug, to wit, morphine, without lawful authority, and for his said offence was sentenced to six months' imprisonment at the Common Gaol at Nelson.

THAT on the 12th October last, upon sufficient evidence of the insanity of the said Donald Perry Percival it was ordered (Order in Council No. 1216) that the said Donald Perry Percival be removed from the said Common Gaol at Nelson aforesaid to the Mental Hospital at Essondale, there to remain until his complete or partial recovery should be certified to the satisfaction of the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

AND WHEREAS the complete recovery of the said Donald Perry Percival is certified to the satisfaction of the Lieutenant Governor in Council by the Medical Superintendent of the said Mental Hospital.

AND TO RECOMMEND that the said Donald Perry Percival be delivered to an Officer armed with the original warrant of commitment for conveyance to the Common Gaol at Nelson aforesaid, there to be delivered to the keeper thereof, and that he be detained in custody therein under the said warrant until the expiration of the term of imprisonment of the said Donald Perry Percival for his said offence

AND THAT a certified copy of this Minute, if approved, be forwarded to the Superintendent of Provincial Police.
