By Law No 98 - 1923
NEW SHAUGHNESSY STREET LIGHTING BYLAW NO. 59, 1923.,
REPEAL BYLAW NO. 98, 1923.

WHEREAS "New Shaughnessy Street Lighting Bylaw No. 59, 1923" was, before being submitted to the electors as provided therein, not sufficiently advertised to comply with the provisions of the "Municipal Act" and the Inspector of Municipalities has, therefore, declined to give his Certificate approving the said By-law, pursuant to the "Municipal Act", and it is expedient and in the public interest that said Bylaw be repealed.

NOW THEREFORE the Reeve and Council of the Corporation of Point Grey in open meeting assembled hereby enact as follows:-

(1) This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "New Shaughnessy Street Lighting Bylaw No. 59, 1923 Repeal Bylaw No. 98, 1923;

(2) "New Shaughnessy Street Lighting Bylaw No. 59, 1923 is hereby repealed;

(3) This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the assent of the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council being given.
