To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT as provided by Section 3 of the "Municipalities Aid Act" it is enacted that the Minister of Finance shall pay from Consolidated Revenue Fund an amount equal to the aggregate of the taxes collected from time to time under the "Amusement Tax Act" in respect of moneys deposited for the purpose of betting at race meetings under the system known as the Pari-mutuel.

AND WHEREAS by Section 4 of the said Act the said Minister is empowered from time to time to

- (a) Apportion all amounts appropriated under this Act among the several municipalities in the Province in proportion to their respective population;
- (b) Determine the times in each year when apportionments shall be made under this Act;
- (c) Prescribe the method by which the population of each municipality shall be determined for the purposes of this Act:

AND WHEREAS there is a sum of \$223,593.08 available for distribution under the provisions of the said Act, and, by virtue of the powers in that behalf, the Minister has apportioned the amounts as set out in the schedule hereto attached, prescribed the method by which the population of the municipalities entitled to participate in such distribution shall be determined and fixed the times when the apportionments shall be made:

AND TO RECOMMEND that the action of the said Minister be, and the same is hereby approved:

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND that the payment of the amounts set out in the fourth column in the Schedule attached to the Municipalities named in the second column of the said Schedule be approved and confirmed.


