The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to REPORT

WHEREAS certain charges were made by the late Sheriff F. G. Richards against C. E. Wilson, Solicitor for Messrs. Crane & Company of Seattle, in respect of services in connection with a replevy order in the year 1922,

AND WHEREAS disputes arose in respect of these charges on the ground of over-charge in respect of possession money of One (\$1.00) Dollar a day which in fact was never earned.

AND WHEREAS with a view of preventing proceedings, it has been deemed advisable to compromise the claim of the late sheriff and accept the sum of One hundred and fifty (\$150.00) Dollars in settlement in full in lieu of the sum of Four hundred and twenty 75/100 (\$420.75) Dollars.

Recommend that the claim of the late sheriff amounting to Four hundred and twenty 75/100 (\$420.75) Dollars be compromised with the said C. E. Wilson at the sum of One hundred and fifty (\$150.00) Dollars.
