The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

resc. of 3027/46

THAT by Order in Council No. 1397 approved the 13th day of October, 1943, all vacant Crown land throughout the Province of British Columbia was reserved against any alienation under the provisions of the Land Act for purposes of public advantage:

THAT a great deal of difficulty has occurred since the establishment of this reserve in dealing with applications for town lots, and parcels of land that have reverted to the Crown under the provisions of the Taxation Act; also applications for leases of foreshore and other lands required for industrial purposes of various kinds:

THAT in order to grant any of such applications it is necessary that the reserve, above referred to, be cancelled in so far as it relates to the lot or parcel of land applied for; and that such cancellation necessitates the passage of an order in council as well as the publication of notice of such cancellation in the British Columbia Gazette, and in a newspaper published in the district for a period of thirty days:

THAT owing to the expense of such publication, and the delays incurred in so dealing with the applications referred to, it is deemed advisable that some revision may be made in the reserve in question:

AND TO RECOMMEND:

THAT pursuant to the provisions of Section 93 of the Land Act, Chapter 144, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1936, all vacant Crown lands throughout the Province, except town lots, foreshore lands, and lands covered with water, and also such lands as may be applied for by pre-emption in cases where it is considered the disposal of such lands will not adversely affect the purposes of the reserve, be reserved against any alienation under the provisions of the Land Act for purposes of public advantage.
