Pursuant to the CRIMINAL CODE ~~AND~~ and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

WHEREAS Dennis PARISEAU was charged with trafficking in a narcotic and trafficking in a substance held out or, represented by him to be a narcotic and by Order of a Judge of the Provincial Court at Vancouver on February 3, 1976 was on account of insanity found unfit to stand his trial and was ordered to be kept in custody in the Riverside Unit of Riverview Hospital, now known as the Forensic Psychiatric Institute, until the pleasure of the Lieutenant-Governor is known and regarding whom satisfactory evidence has been submitted that he has recovered from his mental illness;

Dennis PARISEAU be taken to a Court of competent jurisdiction for trial or other disposition according to law.
