EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA JUN. 3 1976

Pursuant to the ~~Lieutenant - Governor~~ ^{Forest} Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the ~~Administrator~~, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that Finlay Forest Industries Ltd. of Vancouver, British Columbia be permitted to export from the Province a maximum of 110,000 short tons per year of refiner groundwood pulp (mechanical woodpulp) produced in its pulpmill at Mackenzie, British Columbia.

Destination of the pulp product will be Japan, United States, Mexico and other unspecified countries.

Provided that this Order shall expire April 30, 1979.
