Pursuant to the Lieutenant - Governor Municipal Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the ~~Administrator~~ and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the District of Surrey has by By-law No. 4663, cited as "Lane between 111A Avenue and 112th Avenue Closing By-law, 1975, No. 4663", a copy of which is attached hereto, stopped up and closed to traffic that portion of lane as shown outlined in red colour on the plan attached to and made part of said By-law No. 4663, more particularly described as :

"Parcel A, (By-law Plan 49288) of Section 14 Block 5 North Range 2 West Plan 14022 New Westminster District."

AND WHEREAS the Council has requested the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to abandon the aforesaid portion of highway pursuant to section 508 and to vest title to the land comprising same in the name of the municipality and has demonstrated to the satisfaction of the Minister of Municipal Affairs that special circumstances exist which warrant the making of this Order:

AND THAT with the exception of the consent of the owner of Lot 3, Block 28, Plan 19039, the consent of the owners of contiguous properties has been obtained and the question of access is not in issue:

THE REQUEST BE GRANTED and that the portion of highway aforesaid be abandoned and title to the lands comprising same be vested in fee simple in the name of The Corporation of the District of Surrey without further instrument of transfer subject nevertheless to the reservations, limitations, provisos and conditions expressed in the original grant thereof from the Crown and subject to the provisions of section 47 of the Land Act.

A by-law to stop up and close a lane
in Section 14, Block Five North, Range
Two West, New Westminster District.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District
of Surrey may by By-law stop-up and close to traffic a highway
or any portion of a highway;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the
District of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. That portion of lane in Section Fourteen (14), Block
Five (5) North, Range Two (2) West, Plan Fourteen
Thousand Twenty-two (14022), New Westminster District
as shown outlined red on by-law plan attached hereto
and prepared by R.J. Gregory, B.C.L.S. on November 5,
1975, is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
2. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as "Lane
between 111A Avenue and 112th Avenue Closing By-law,
1975, No. 4663".

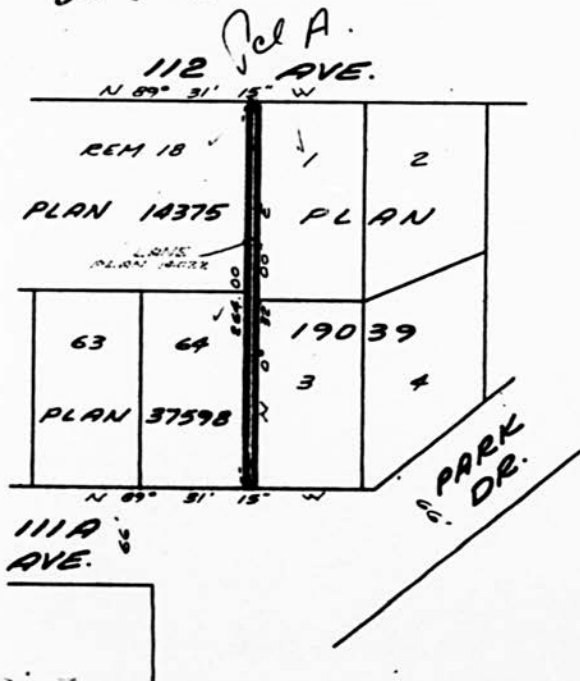
