W EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA JUN. 3 1976

Pursuant to the NATURAL PRODUCTS MARKETING
(BRITISH COLUMBIA) Act, and upon the recommendation

of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that B.C. Reg. 173/67, approved by Order-in-Council No. 2263/67 on the 13th day of July, 1967, as amended, be further amended by adding immediately after section 4 (3) of Part I the following:

- "(4) The Agency shall have the authority to fix the price or prices, maximum price or prices, minimum price or prices, or both maximum and minimum prices at which that part of the regulated product meeting Canada Grade A standards may be bought or sold in the Province, or that shall be paid for that part by a designated agency, and to fix different prices for different parts of the Province:"

and by striking out section 1.02 (e) of Part II and substituting therefor the following:

- "(e) 'egg production unit' means the land and buildings comprising a poultry farm at which a registered producer keeps layers owned by him and used for the purpose of producing eggs to be marketed in accordance with marketing quota or marketing permit."

and by striking out section 4.01 (j) of Part II and substituting therefor the following:

- "(j) To fix, subject to the provisions of section 4(3) of Part I, the minimum price or prices paid to the registered producer for the regulated product, or any grade or class thereof, in the Province, and may fix different prices for different areas of the Province:"
