Pursuant to the R A I L W A Y Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

WHEREAS the British Columbia Railway Company requested approval for replacement of the switch at the connecting point between the Northern Alberta Railway and the British Columbia Railway at Dawson Creek, British Columbia:

AND WHEREAS installation of continuous standard steel trackage will facilitate interchange of traffic between the two companies at this location:

WHEREAS by his Certificate No. 972 approved by Order-in-Council No. 2765 of December 4, 1958, the Minister of Transport and Communications granted approval to the British Columbia Railway Company to connect its trackage with the trackage of the Northern Alberta Railways Company to facilitate interchange of traffic between the two companies at Dawson Creek, British Columbia:

AND WHEREAS application has been made by the British Columbia Railway Company to replace the switch at the connecting point between the two Railways by installing continuous standard steel trackage:
