The purpose of this Bill is to provide power to make regulations respecting the payment of grants to encourage and reward safe drivers and owners of vehicles.

Motor-vehicle Amendment Act, 1976 (No. 2)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:

1. Section 81 (1) of the *Motor-vehicle Act* is amended
 - (a) by striking out "and" at the end of paragraph (x),
 - (b) by striking out the period at the end of paragraph (y) and substituting a semi-colon, and
 - (c) by adding the following after paragraph (y):
 - (z) providing for
 - (i) the payment of grants to any class of driver or owner of a vehicle for the purpose of encouraging and rewarding the safe operation of vehicles on the highway, and
 - (ii) the determination of the amount and conditions of payment, class of drivers or vehicles, and any other matter relating to fair and orderly payment.
