EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA SEP. 2 1976

Pursuant to the Municipal Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the District of Surrey has by By-law No. 4582 cited as "Portions of 126A Street Road Closing By-law, 1975 No. 4582" a copy of which is hereto attached, stopped up and closed to traffic that portion of 126A Street as shown outlined in red colour on the plan attached to and made part of said By-law No. 4582 more particularly described as follows:

"Parcels 'R' and 'S' (By-law Plan 48745)  
of the South East Quarter of Section 31  
Township 2 Plan 2135 New Westminster District"

AND WHEREAS the Council has requested the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to abandon the aforesaid portion of highway pursuant to section 508 and to vest title to the land comprising same in the name of the municipality and has demonstrated to the satisfaction of the Minister of Municipal Affairs that special circumstances exist which warrant the making of this Order:

AND WHEREAS the consent of owners of contiguous properties has been obtained and the question of access is not in issue:

*W* THE REQUEST BE GRANTED and that the portion of highway aforesaid be abandoned and title to the lands comprising same be vested in fee simple in the name of The Corporation of the District of Surrey without further instrument of transfer subject nevertheless to the reservations, limitations, provisos and conditions expressed in the original grant thereof from the Crown and subject to the provisions of section 47 of the Land Act.

BY-LAW NO. 4582

A By-law to stop up and close portions of 126A Street in Section 31, Township 2, Plan 2135, Plan 42267, and Plan 4017

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Surrey may by by-law stop up and close to traffic a highway or any portions of a highway;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. All and singular those parcels or tracts of land and premises situate lying and being in the Municipality of Surrey in the Province of British Columbia and being:


THOSE PORTIONS OF ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SIX "A" (126 "A") STREET IN THE SOUTH EAST QUARTER OF SECTION THIRTY-ONE (31) TOWNSHIP (2) NEW WESTMINSTER DISTRICT AS SHOWN OUTLINED RED ON BY-LAW PLAN ATTACHED HERETO AND PREPARED BY JAMES DAVIDSON, B.C.L.S. ON OCTOBER 4, 1973.


are hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

2. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Portions of 126A Street Road Closing By-law, 1975, No. 4582."

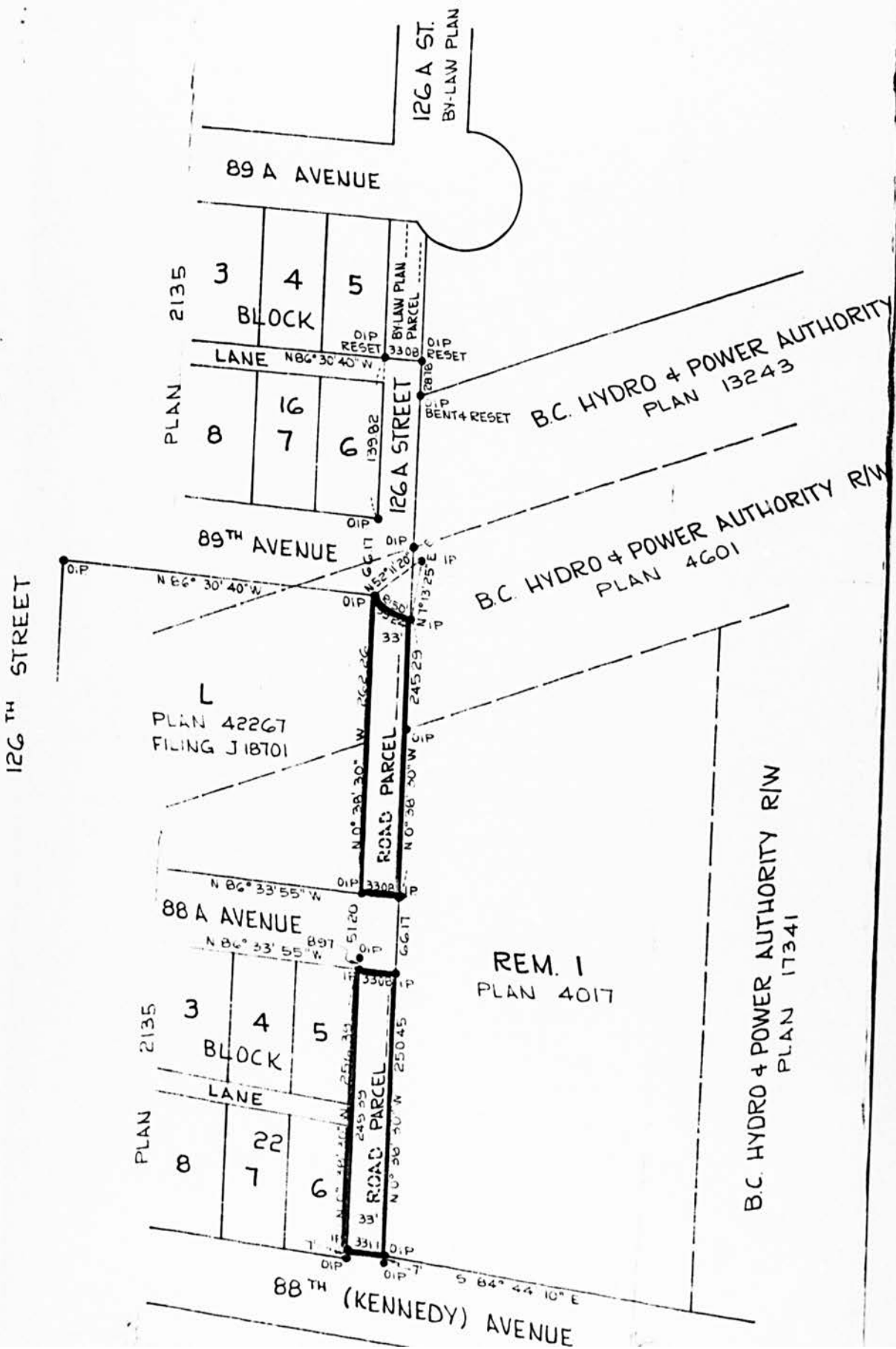
