AND WHEREAS in 1975 the children of British Columbia collected \$79,313.00 which provided food, medical and educational aid for children less fortunate in 109 developing countries:

AND WHEREAS for the purpose of recognizing the importance of the interest and support of the people of British Columbia in the work of UNICEF, it is desirable to appoint Saturday, October 30, 1976, as UNICEF Day in the Province of British Columbia:
