Pursuant to the **British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority Act, 1964**, ~~xxx~~ and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the ~~Administrator~~ Administrator, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that on the recommendation of British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority, and for a purpose related to the exercise of the powers of the Authority, namely, to construct, operate and maintain on, over and under the land referred to as "the land" in the Schedule attached hereto, and other land, an electrical transmission line or lines from the British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority Barnard Substation in Burnaby to the British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority Horne Payne Substation in Burnaby, both in the Province of British Columbia, for the distribution and supply of electricity, British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority is hereby authorized, without the consent of the owner or of any other person, to take by expropriation in accordance with the provisions of the said Act the real property being the interest or limited interest in land described in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

A right of way on, over and under:

The 0.29 acre portion of the Common Property of Strata Plan NW 64, District Lot Seventy-Four (74), Group One (1), New Westminster District, in the Province of British Columbia, which portion (hereinafter called "the land") is shown outlined in red on a plan deposited in the New Westminster Land Registry Office and numbered 50513,

being the right, liberty and right of way for British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority (hereinafter called "B. C. Hydro"), its servants, agents and all others the licensees of B. C. Hydro:

(a) To excavate for, install, operate, maintain, remove and replace (with conduits or cables of the initial or any other size) one or more underground cables with or without conduits, whether or not encased by concrete or other protective material, with all necessary attachments and fittings for the transmission and distribution of electric energy and for communication purposes (all of which are hereinafter collectively called "the works");

(b) And to clear the land and keep it cleared of all or any part of any trees, growth, buildings or obstructions now or hereafter on or under the land which might, in the opinion of Hydro, interfere with or endanger the installation, operation, maintenance, removal or replacement of the works or any part thereof;

(c) And to enter and pass upon, along, over and under and to have unobstructed access over and under the land or any part thereof;

(d) And generally to do all acts necessary or incidental to the business of B. C. Hydro in connection with the foregoing.
