Bk. "A"

Commencing at a point on the right bank of Wansa Creek, Cariboo Land District, said point being 6 kilometres East and 4.3 kilometres South of the confluence of Wansa Creek and Willow River; thence due East a distance of 10 kilometres; thence due North a distance of 9.4 kilometres; thence due East a distance of 4.5 kilometres; thence due South a distance of 7.8 kilometres; thence due East a distance of 8.6 kilometres; thence due North a distance of 8.4 kilometres; thence due East a distance of 2.8 kilometres; thence due South a distance of 10.8 kilometres; thence due West a distance of 6.2 kilometres; thence due South a distance of 3.1 kilometres; thence South 45 degrees West a distance of 4 kilometres, more or less, to a point on the left bank of the Bowron River; thence in a generally South-Easterly direction along the said left bank of the Bowron River to a point being 1.4 kilometres West and 4.4 kilometres North of the confluence of Indianpoint Creek and the Bowron River; thence South 67 degrees West a distance of 6.6 kilometres; thence South 4 degrees West a distance of 18 kilometres; thence due East a distance of 12.2 kilometres; thence North 52 degrees West a distance of 23.6 kilometres; thence North 1 degree West a distance of 45.8 kilometres, more or less, to a point on the right bank of Wansa Creek; thence in a generally North-Westerly and Northerly direction along the right bank of Wansa Creek to the point of commencement.

Commencing at a point, said point being 4 kilometres South and 6.5 kilometres West of the confluence of Slim Creek and the Fraser River, Cariboo Land District; thence South 3 degrees East a distance of 13.6 kilometres; thence South 68 degrees West a distance of 5.8 kilometres; thence North 23 degrees West a distance of 2 kilometres; thence North 66 degrees East a distance of 5 kilometres; thence North 17 degrees West a distance of 6.4 kilometres; thence South 66 degrees West a distance of 12 kilometres; thence North 76 degrees West a distance of 8.4 kilometres; thence due North a distance of 3.4 kilometres; thence South 82 degrees East a distance of 7.2 kilometres; thence due North a distance of 3.2 kilometres; thence North 63 degrees East a distance of 6 kilometres; thence due East a distance of 8.4 kilometres, more or less, to the point of commencement.

Bk. "C"

Commencing at a point on the left bank of the Fraser River, said point being 3.3 kilometres East and 1.4 kilometres South of the confluence of Hungary Creek and the Fraser River, Cariboo Land District; thence in a generally Easterly direction along the left bank of the Fraser River to a point, said point being 9.3 kilometres East and 3.4 kilometres South of the confluence of Hungary Creek and the Fraser River; thence due South a distance of 4 kilometres more or less to the Northerly limit of a reserve (F 02/1915) established for highway No. 16; thence in a generally North-Westerly direction along the Northerly limit of said highway reserve to a point due South of the point of commencement; thence due North a distance of 3.4 kilometres, more or less, to the point of commencement.

Bk. "D"

Commencing at a point, said point being 5.6 kilometres South and 0.5 kilometres West of the confluence of Fleet Creek, and the Fraser River, Cariboo Land District; thence South 65 degrees East a distance of 1.5 kilometres; thence South 25 degrees West a distance of 2.2 kilometres; thence North 65 degrees West a distance of 1.5 kilometres; thence North 25 degrees East a distance of 2.2 kilometres to the point of commencement.

Bk. "E"

Commencing at a point, said point being 5.8 kilometres East and 8.8 kilometres South of the confluence of Swift Creek and the McLennan River, Cariboo Land District; thence South 66 degrees East a distance of 1.2 kilometres; thence South 24 degrees West a distance of 0.8 kilometres; thence North 66 degrees West a distance of 1.2 kilometres; thence North 24 degrees East a distance of 0.8 kilometres to the point of commencement.

Bk. "F"

Commencing at a point on the Easterly limit of the Canoe River Forest Road Right-of-Way, said point being 11 kilometres East and 8.2 kilometres South of the confluence of Swift Creek and the McLennan River, Cariboo Land District; thence North 58 degrees East a distance of 4.6 kilometres; thence South 35 degrees East a distance of 10.5 kilometres; thence South 60 degrees West a distance of 4.5 kilometres more or less to the Easterly limit of the Canoe River Forest Road Right-of-Way; thence in a generally North-Westerly direction along the Easterly limit of said right-of-way to the point of commencement.

Bk. "G"

Commencing at a point on the left bank of Indianpoint Creek, said point being 12.5 kilometres East and 6 kilometres South of the confluence of Indianpoint Creek and the Bowron River, Cariboo Land District; thence South 79 degrees West a distance of 2 kilometres; thence North 23 degrees West a distance of 3 kilometres; thence North 72 degrees East a distance of 0.6 kilometres more or less to a point on the left bank of Indianpoint Creek; thence in a generally South-Easterly direction along the said left bank of Indianpoint Creek to the point of commencement.

Bk. "H"

Commencing at a point, said point being 1.6 kilometres East and 12.6 kilometres South of the confluence of Indianpoint Creek and the Bowron River, Cariboo Land District; thence due South a distance of 2.3 kilometres more or less, to a point of the left bank of Towkuh Creek; thence in a generally Easterly direction along the said left bank of Towkuh Creek to the confluence of Towkuh Creek and the Bowron River; thence in a generally Northerly direction along the left bank of the Bowron River to a point due West of a point, said point being 9.6 kilometres East and 12.8 kilometres South of the confluence of Indianpoint Creek and the Bowron River; thence due East a distance of 2.8 kilometres to said point; thence due North a distance of 3.6 kilometres; thence due West a distance of 3.8 kilometres, more or less, to a point on the right bank of the Bowron River; thence in a generally South-Easterly direction along the right bank of the Bowron River to a point due East of the point of commencement; thence due West a distance of 4.6 kilometres, more or less, to the point of commencement.
